Additional Upgrade Details:

Blogs: We are building a new dedicated Blog functionality directly into Simpplr One, slated for release in the first half of 2026.

What this means for your existing blogs: For clients leveraging Simpplr Classic's blog, the current process is to create a public site and ask to add blog posts as pages.

Once the new Blogs are rolled out, clients will have these two options:

- Option A (Continue Current Use): Your existing blog-style Pages will remain fully accessible in their current public sites and will not be impacted.
- Option B (Adopt New Feature): Once the new Blog functionality is available, you will have the ability to simply copy and paste the content from your existing Pages into the new, dedicated blog post format.

Polls: Enhanced Polls with Audience-Based Access Controls, which is slated for release Jan '26.

A net new Poll functionality is under development for Simpplr One. This feature is associated with Audience Based Access Controls (ABAC) for more targeted feedback.

Due to the fundamental shift in how this new feature works, historical poll data will not be transferred during the upgrade.

If your team wishes to retain this data, you can proactively request that the upgrade team pull your historical poll data for your records. Please coordinate this request with your Simpplr contact.

Featured Sites for Segmentation: The Audience Based Access Control (ABAC) enhancement, will change how featured sites work for segments. You'll no longer need to manage them at the segment level because sites are being mapped to audiences. App managers and the Manage Sites Access Control Groups Manager will be able to update the featured sites directly by navigating to Sites> Featured> Add/Update.

Please note, these changes don't impact your end users' visibility.
